### **Water Quality Report Available**

The latest edition of Spencer Municipal Utilities' annual Consumer Confidence Report on water quality has been prepared and is being distributed electronically to customers through SMU's website at www.smunet.net/2024CCR.

The report provides details of drinking water testing conducted during the calendar year 2023. SMU regularly tests over 80 drinking water contaminants, and the 2023 data again shows no violations of EPA rules for water quality.

"Our wells are based in an aquifer that is a high quality source, which we improve for our customers with disinfection and lime softening," says Amanda Gloyd, SMU marketing & community relations manager. In addition to showing the results of water testing from last year, the Consumer Confidence Report also gives customers details on SMU's water source, treatment methods, and other important health information.


# **Flagfest**


